I was glad to get your letter. I think it speaks well of people who are interested in their ancestors. Let's start at the begining - The Marmen genealogical library at Salt Lake City which is said to be the best + most complete library of its kind in the country, says they think our people are of Swiss origin. The name was spelled differently over there. It was not unusual for the spelling of names to change in the days when so many people were illiterate. They find Zuercher, Zucher, Zarker etc, all of which sound much like we pronounce Zarecor. There are passenger lists of Zucher and another spelling coming to Pennsylvania in the 1600^s. I have copies of a couple of them somewhere but can't find them. John ca 1745 was born in Pa. He was married to Hothrina - Their children were

I have no copy
 between John & Mary & the rest of
 the family for many years

Son John & Jane must have had a "falling out" with
 the rest of the family because they left and came to
 Sumner Co. TN. They seem to have accumulated quite
 a bit of land because I have deeds showing that Mary
 bought the inheritance of a couple of her sisters. The deeds
 show about 100 acres or a little more for each so if all
 inherited the same, it would add up. One of the sisters
 was married to a Webb but I've forgotten which one. I have a
 deed for 200 acres to John from a Dobbes and I believe he
 had a good land grant. The name on the deed is spelled
 Syarben³

A lot of names spelling was changed when a document was written and the person couldn't spell his name so who ever was writing, spelled it like it sounded to him.

I don't know when John + Jane lived but the Dobbin property ~~was~~ was in what was that time Roberson Co.

I think that county was divided, so Sumner Co may have been part of it. The property was on Red River which should place it on the Western edge of Sumner Co.

George + Mary Armfield lived West of Gallatin two or three miles S W of Cotton town. I went there once. Mary was buried on the farm. I don't know anything about your branch of the family. One of my ancestors (not a Zarecas) came with James Robertson when they settled Nashville. He was described in a book I came across as a Frontiersman, Long Hunter and Indian fighter. He, ~~Robertson~~ ~~Roberson~~? Robertson, + some had been to the Nashville area hunting and liked the area so later they moved their families there. One was the Donaldson family. My William Neely helped keep the Indians fought back while the others built Ft. Nashboro. I have got so I can no longer spell and never could write well. William was ~~hit~~ killed by Indians.

Would like to have what ever you have on Tibbatts + webbs descendants.
