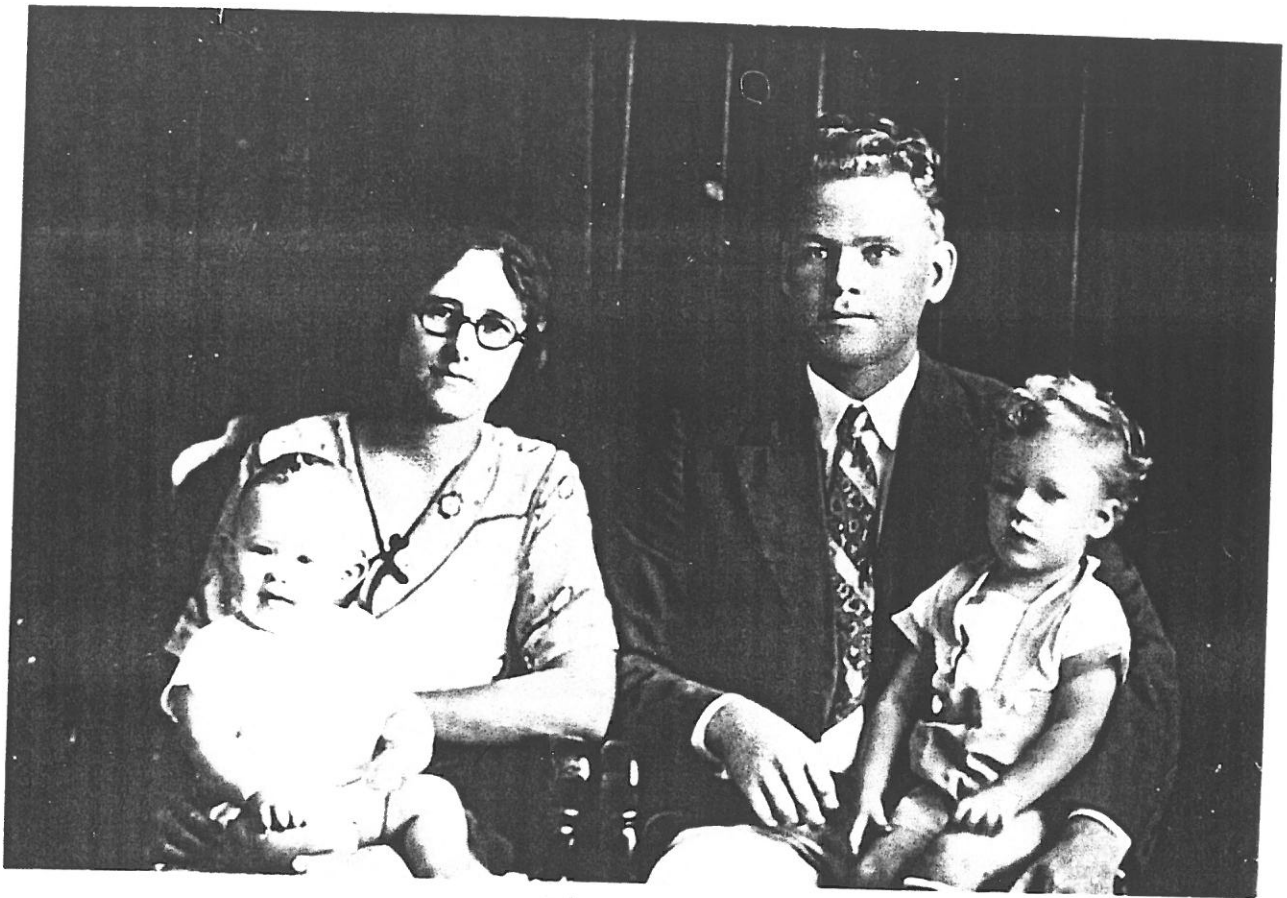

 about June, 1917. I went to country school for 7th & 8th grade school.
 September, 1921 I went to San Fernando Academy where I graduated May 1923. ^{9th & 10th grades, Arroyo Grande church school}
 I graduated Pacific Union College from secretarial course June, 1924.
 Married Aaron V. Larson March 4, 1925. (??//Widdowed May 3, 1975)

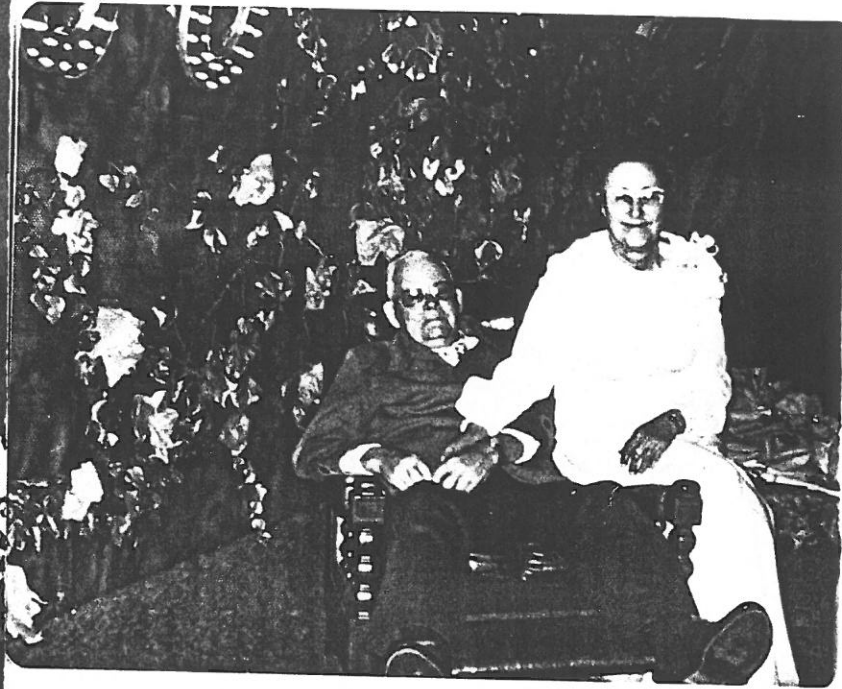

Aaron Larson was born in Oberlin, Kansas. They moved to Escondido, Ca. when Aaron was about 14, and later moved to Chowchilla, ca. where they did dairy farming.

Lela Wood-Larson was born in Nebraska and grew up in Arroyo Grande, Ca. Lela's mother died of cancer but her father lived to be 95. They are buried in the Arroyo Grande

When Lela and Aaron where newlyweds they went to Central America as missionaries. He was a Literature Evangelist, Minister, Businesss Manager of a Publishing House and Inter-American Union Division President.

Aaron died of leukemia in May of 1975 and is buried in Chowchilla, Ca.
