Mitchell, Clerk & Master of Chancery Court, White County: "...I did find the graves of one Nathan and his wife, which proved to be the Nathan whose estate was settled in 1837 to 1840. These two graves are marked with heavy slabs of mountain stone set roof style over them and with the following inscriptions: 'Here lies the body of Nathan BARTLETT, Decd April 20, 1837, aged 86.'

[Note: Putnam Co., TN was formed 1842 from White County, the formation declared unconstitutional and abolished, then re-established in 1854. Prior to 1842, Dry Valley was located in what was then White County.]

Notes for Joseph Bartlett:

In 1791 the family moved to Hawkins Co, TN where the mother died about 1793-94. Joseph, not knowing what to do with the three children, placed them in the custody of their Grandmother SIMS. Also helpful with the children was their Aunt Lucy CHISHOLM. By 1796 Joseph had married Millicent RICE and started a second family. About 1810 Joseph and his family moved from Hawkins County to White Co., TN, remaining there through at least 1815 [Tax lists-land on Phillips Crk]. From May 1824 through Feb 1836 Joseph and Millicent were members of the Spring Creek Baptist Church (Overton/Jackson Co., TN).

The 1820 census for Overton Co., TN shows Joseph Bartlett with 7 boys and 2 girls at home. His nearest neighbors were: William Weaver, William Quarles, Josiah Marchbanks, and William Bullock. he purchased property on Spring Creek in 1824 - - the deed was witnessed by Jesse Bartlett. Other property was purchased on Spring Creek by: Isaac Bartlett (1828), Nathan Bartlett (1831) and Joseph Bartlett (1840). William Bartlett was in Illinois for a period around 1831 but returned to Tennessee. At present, records of descendants of this family are available only for William, Evan and Joshua. Joshua is buried in an unmarked grave on the Joshua BARTLETT Farm, South of Falling Water, Putnam Co., TN. His Will was dated Sep. 23, 1823 and proven July 4 or 14, 1828, White Co., TN. Winifred WILLIAMS BARTLETT is buried in Brown's Mill, Putnam Co., TN.

From the Early History of Putnam County, Tennessee, by W. S. McClain, 1925:

Joshua BARTLETT and wife (Winnie, nee WILLIAMS) moved from Boonesborough, KY with their eight children about the year 1808 and built a cabin on the south bank of Falling Water, near the location of the concrete bridge on the new highway through there.

Later Mr. BARTLETT erected a larger and better residence (now occupied by Dudley FARLEY) near the original cabin, which was then used for several years as a church and school house, but was finally abandoned for a new building on the north bank of Falling River, the site of the present Brown's Mill Church. The BARTLETT children were named Daniel, Nathan, Joseph, Edith, Rebecca, Dorcas, Nancy and Penelope. Another daughter, Hester, was born in their new home in 1812, and was the grandmother of Claude BROWN, who gave us this information. Mr. BROWN's mother, widow of the late Hyram BROWN, now in her 87th year, remembers clearly the details of the capture of Daniel BOONE's daughters by the Indians, in a raid on Boonesborough, as related by her mother. The original entry of land by Mr. BARTLETT embraced 360 acres on Falling Water, the bottom land thickly covered by tall cane.

JOSHUA BARTLETT of White County, Tennessee served in the War of 1812 for the period from Oct. 4, 1813 to Jan. 4, 1814 in the 1st Regiment of West Tennessee Militia (Wynne's), Capt. Holleman's Company. Bounty Land Warrant 88729-40-50 relates to the application of Winney BARTLETT, his widow, which was accepted Nov. 17, 1852. The following is a copy of her application.

On this 31st day of January A. D. one Thousand Eight hundred and fifty two personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid, WINNEY BARTLET, aged 84 years, a resident of White County in the State of Tennessee who being duly sworn according to Law, declares that she is the widow of JOSHUA BARTLET deceased, who was a private in the company commanded by Captain James HULLOWMAN [HOLLEMAN], in the 1st Regiment of Tennessee Militia commanded by Col. John K. WINN in the War of 1812, against the Creek Indians; that her husband drafted at Williamsburg, Jackson County, on or

about the 20th day of September A. D. 1813, for the term of three months, and was honorable discharged at Fort Deposit on the 20th day of January A. D. 1814.

She further states, that she was married to the said JOSHUA BARTLET, in Maddison [sic] County, Kentucky, on the _____ day of _____ A. D. by one STONE, a minister of the Gospel, and that her name, before her said marriage was WINNY WILLIAMS, that her said husband died at White County, Tennessee on the 22nd day of april, A. D. 1831, and that she is still a widow, & his discharge lost.

She makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the Bounty land to which she may be entitled under the Act passed 28th September 1850.

On Sep 4, 1837, Joseph BARTLETT, of Taney Co, MO, sold his portion of "Father" Nathan BARTLETT's estate to his brother James BARTLETT. At the same time he gave power of attorney for James to collect what he was due as one of the heirs of Nathan BARTLETT, dec'd. [White Co. TN DB L: 360-362...cas]

By 1840, William and Joseph BARTLETT, sons of Nathan, had moved to MO. Only son James BARTLETT was recorded in the 1840 White Co, TN census. [1840 MO Census. Taney Co, Swan Twp, p. 115].

By 1845-46 Joseph A. BARTLETT had settled in Texas in a town called Fenton (which no longer exists) on the banks of the Trinity River as part of the C. F. Mercer Colony. He was there operating a ferry across the Trinity River by 1846 and advertising his services in two newspapers, including the Northern Standard, and was one of the founders of Henderson County which was formed in 1846 from Nacogdoches and Houston Counties. [1850 Census, Henderson Co, TX; occu. Merchant]

Joseph owned 640 acres of land on a bluff on the East side of and overlooking a large bend in the Trinity River, with his property extending down to the river, and his son, John R., owned 320 acres of land adjoining his father's property on the North, also with water frontage on the Trinity River.

Joseph's wife, Elizabeth died while the family was in Henderson Co. and is likely buried somewhere on Joseph's property. She is not listed in any cemetery sites in Henderson or Navarro Co. and since Joseph stated in his will that he wanted to be buried on his property in Live Oak Co., we assume he buried Elizabeth on his property in Henderson Co. in the same way.

They sold all of their land in Henderson County in April 1854, and by 1856 Joseph and his family had relocated to Oakville, Live Oak Co, TX. This house site and other land was acquired by Joseph BARTLETT by deed recorded August 18, 1857 in Vol. A, page 131 - Live Oak Co, TX. This was the Eagle House, so named when it was built because it had a huge bronze eagle erected on the roof (possibly a weather vane). Some say the style of the roof has been changed and the Eagle has taken flight to unknown land.

Filed in Vol. A. on page 168, dated August 18, 1857, Joseph BARTLETT was given a contract to build the first Court House and Jail combination which was constructed on the square across the street from his home. Before and during the time the County's Court House was being built, the County Clerk's Office was in the BARTLETT home. This house was also used as a Hotel during the BARTLETT ownership and later served the community as the Telephone Company Exchange office.

The house is still there but is falling down and the property, overgrown with brush and vines, is in disrepair. Joseph A. BARTLETT requested in his Will that he be buried at the back of his property behind his home. His grave is located just off the Interstate frontage about 100-125 feet from the corner of the Interstate frontage and the road passing in front of the house and the old County Jail built in 1857. It is about 15 feet off the road about 5 feet south of a utility pole on the property line.

Sometime after the county seat was moved to George West, the original courthouse was demolished and the stone used for other construction. The grave and marker are still standing as of Feb 1999 after some major repair. On Joseph's monument there are engravings on three sides. North side: "Is appointed unto man once to die, and after death the Judgement". West side: Joseph BARTLETT b. Jan 3, 1802, d. May 3, 1880. South side: Erected to the memory of Joseph BARTLETT by his wife Mollie A. BARTLETT. I have a copy of Joseph's will, recorded in Live Oak Co, TX. [Note...cas: This was Joseph's second wife, maiden name of Mary Ann MCWORTER.]

Other researcers have stated that "Elizabeth, the daughter of Joseph BARTLETT and Millicent RICE married her cousin, Joseph, the son of Nathan". I have not been able to prove this through documentation, but circumstantial evidence leads me to this conclusion also. Joseph and Millicent went to MO during the same time frame as others in Joseph BARTLETT's and Millicent's family. Joseph and Elizabeth named their first child Milery, Mildred or Milly (could also have been Millicent). Their second child is named John R. (possibly after Millicent RICE's father, John RICE). Another thing very much of interest is that John R. had a son called "Ridder", who went with Oscar (another son) to Mexico. Members of Oscar's family said Ridder was also known as George Rice BARTLETT. This was the name I had before discovering anything about the RICE family. This would further confirm suspicion that the Joseph BARTLETT who married Millicent RICE is a brother of Nathan BARTLETT who married Peggy HUNTER. [Carol A. Selandar]

He went there with Thomas HILL and his son Abner HILL who had planned to locate a home in White Co, TN. In the fall of 1806 the HILLs returned to Claiborne Co. to bring their family out. James BARTLETT joined them in going to Claiborne Co. On the return trip all three of the BARTLETT young folks came along, viz: James, John and Sarah. During the trip Abner fell in love with Sarah and they were married in Dec 1806.

James BARTLETT decided not to return to Claiborne Co, but to join his uncles, Nathan BARTLETT and Joshua BARTLETT, in Dry Valley, White Co, who were brothers to his father, Joseph BARTLETT. Actually Joseph BARTLETT had moved from Hawkins Co. to Dry Valley, White Co, TN by 1810. James was a very active man and soon married Nancy (maiden name unknown). He also made an entry of 227 acres of land in Dry Valley adjoining Joshua BARTLETT. It wasn't long until he started a family in which he had two boys, Thompson Martin and John. We do not know their exact ages. He obtained the grant on the 227 acres by 1812.

In Dec 1814 he sold 167 acres to Joshua Bartlett leaving him with 60 acres. Also at this time his health began to fail. As a result he made a Will on June 18, 1815 in which he was leaving his land to his boys and all the rest of his property to Nancy. He died in early July 1815. On Sep 4, 1837, Joseph BARTLETT, of Taney Co, MO, sold his portion of "Father" Nathan BARTLETT's estate to his brother James BARTLETT. At the same time he gave power of attorney for James to collect what he was due as one of the heirs of Nathan BARTLETT, dec'd. [White Co. TN DB L: 360-362...cas]

By 1840, William and Joseph BARTLETT, sons of Nathan, had moved to MO. Only son James BARTLETT was recorded in the 1840 White Co, TN census. [1840 MO Census. Taney Co, Swan Twp, p. 115].

By 1845-46 Joseph A. BARTLETT had settled in Texas in a town called Fenton (which no longer exists) on the banks of the Trinity River as part of the C. F. Mercer Colony. He was there operating a ferry across the Trinity River by 1846 and advertising his services in two newspapers, including the Northern Standard, and was one of the founders of Henderson County which was formed in 1846 from Nacogdoches and Houston Counties. [1850 Census, Henderson Co, TX; occu. Merchant]

Joseph owned 640 acres of land on a bluff on the East side of and overlooking a large bend in the Trinity River, with his property extending down to the river, and his son, John R., owned 320 acres of land adjoining his father's property on the North, also with water frontage on the Trinity River.

Joseph's wife, Elizabeth died while the family was in Henderson Co. and is likely buried somewhere on Joseph's property. She is not listed in any cemetery sites in Henderson or Navarro Co. and since Joseph stated in his will that he wanted to be buried on his property in Live Oak Co., we assume he buried Elizabeth on his property in Henderson Co. in the same way.

They sold all of their land in Henderson County in April 1854, and by 1856 Joseph and his family had relocated to Oakville, Live Oak Co, TX. This house site and other land was acquired by Joseph BARTLETT by deed recorded August 18, 1857 in Vol. A, page 131 - Live Oak Co, TX. This was the Eagle House, so named when it was built because it had a huge bronze eagle erected on the roof (possibly a weather vane). Some say the style of the roof has been changed and the Eagle has taken flight to unknown land.

Filed in Vol. A. on page 168, dated August 18, 1857, Joseph BARTLETT was given a contract to build the first Court House and Jail combination which was constructed on the square across the street from his home. Before and during the time the County's Court House was being built, the County Clerk's Office was in the BARTLETT home. This house was also used as a Hotel during the BARTLETT ownership and later served the community as the Telephone Company Exchange office.

The house is still there but is falling down and the property, overgrown with brush and vines, is in disrepair. Joseph A. BARTLETT requested in his Will that he be buried at the back of his property behind his home. His grave is located just off the Interstate frontage about 100-125 feet from the corner of the Interstate frontage and the road passing in front of the house and the old County Jail built in 1857. It is about 15 feet off the road about 5 feet south of a utility pole on the property line.

Sometime after the county seat was moved to George West, the original courthouse was demolished and the stone used for other construction. The grave and marker are still standing as of Feb 1999 after some major

repair. On Joseph's monument there are engravings on three sides. North side: "Is appointed unto man once to die, and after death the Judgement". West side: Joseph BARTLETT b. Jan 3, 1802, d. May 3, 1880. South side: Erected to the memory of Joseph BARTLETT by his wife Mollie A. BARTLETT. I have a copy of Joseph's will, recorded in Live Oak Co, TX. [Note...cas: This was Joseph's second wife, maiden name of Mary Ann MCWORTER.]

Other researcers have stated that "Elizabeth, the daughter of Joseph BARTLETT and Millicent RICE married her cousin, Joseph, the son of Nathan". I have not been able to prove this through documentation, but circumstantial evidence leads me to this conclusion also. Joseph and Millicent went to MO during the same time frame as others in Joseph BARTLETT's and Millicent's family. Joseph and Elizabeth named their first child Milery, Mildred or Milly (could also have been Millicent). Their second child is named John R. (possibly after Millicent RICE's father, John RICE). Another thing very much of interest is that John R. had a son called "Ridder", who went with Oscar (another son) to Mexico. Members of Oscar's family said Ridder was also known as George Rice BARTLETT. This was the name I had before discovering anything about the RICE family. This would further confirm suspicion that the Joseph BARTLETT who married Millicent RICE is a brother of Nathan BARTLETT who married Peggy HUNTER. [Carol A. Selandar]

During the Civil War, two men were passing through Buffalo Valley, Putnam County, Tennessee on their way to White County, for their families. They were going to move them to Kentucky where they had made new homes. Somewhere in the valley, they were shot and seriously wounded by two Rebel soldiers. The injured men were taken to the home of some people named Garner.

Annie Anderson Bartlett, my grandmother, heard of this and sent my mother (Rebecca Peranna Bartlett), who was about 15 years old at the time, to see if there was anything that they could do for the injured men.

The Garners lived near Thomas Anderson, Jr. and they didn't have bedsteads, just straw beds on the floor. The injured men, later identified as being named Dildine and Barclay, had been placed on two of these rough beds. As my mother entered the room, Mr. Dildine looked up and asked her for a drink of cold water. She started to the spring with a wooden bucket and a gourd dipper when the Garners told her that the Rebels had ordered them not to wait on the injured men and that any one that did would be killed. Mother hurried on and said, "Let 'em kill!"

She brought the water and gave Mr. Barclay a drink and he asked her to pour cold water on him as he was hot with the fever. Mr. Dildine had been shot in the head and by that time, was unable to talk. He died later on that first night. Mother stayed the whole night pouring cold water on Mr. Barclay. The wooden floors were old, so the water soaked right through the straw bed and went right through the floor.

The next day Mr. Barclay asked mother to write a letter to his wife. Mother wrote the letter and Mr. Barclay died that night.

About three weeks later, Mrs. Barclay came horseback with her six-month-old son to meet the people who had befriended her husband in his hour of greatest need. She was very thankful for all kindness shown her husband and told my grandmother that she would send the family a half uh-bushel of salt if they would let Rebecca go with her to bring it back. A horse was saddled for Rebecca, and she left on her long trip to get the salt. They had gotten about as far as Silver Point (about five miles), when Becky lost her courage and began crying. She just could not bear to think of going so far from home. She turned her horse home, the much needed salt was forgotten.

Forty years later, the fears and hates of the war forgotten, Mr. Barclay's son camw to Buffalo Valley to find his father's grave. He wished to remove the bones and lay them at rest beside his mother. Riley Jones, my brother, told of hearing mother tell the story of Mr. Barclay's death and that she might know where Mr. Barclay had been buried. She knew the cemetery, but not the exact grave as there were few tombstones.

That cemetery is now under the mightily Interstate Highway which dissected the valley. That cemetery, with all its occupants, except Thomas Anderson Jr. and Louisa Anderson, whose remains were removed before the road covered the cemetery.

BURIED: Funeral services held at the Baxter Methodist Church, Rev. J.S. Haris officiated. Burial was in the family cemetery, two mile s west of Baxter, near Ensor. WAM visited and photographed this cemet ery in May 1994. It was so "overgrown" that you cannot enter the "walled area" where there were 2 headstones visible. It appears to me as though Roscoe, Minnie and their son are the only one's buried there . This cemetery is located on Dyer Ridge (Road Name) in a plowed field, on the left side as you face from the road.
